PASTOR'S CORNER

St. Margaret of Scotland

"When one door closes, another one opens."

With two failed attempts at traveling to the Holy Land behind me, I now turn to my next attempt to travel abroad. I am returning to Scotland this summer to play golf. (The statute of limitations has expired on the infamous "broken windshield off the 18th tee of the Old Course of St. Andrew's, the birthplace of golf" incident.) {totally true story...devastating when it happened, hilarious now}

People often ask me if we do anything else besides golf on these trips. Of course, we do. Sometimes. My last trip to Scotland we visited Edinburgh Castle, one of the most amazing places on earth. It sits on a high rock of a hill, right smack dab in the middle of Edinburgh, with a fantastic panoramic view of the city. But my favorite spot at the castle was St. Margaret's Chapel, built by King David I, Margaret's son, in 1130. It is still the site of some christenings and weddings and a wondrous shrine to a truly inspirational woman, St. Margaret of Scotland.

Margaret's life began in 1045 in exile. She was the granddaughter of the king of England, but her father was sent into exile, so she actually was born in her great-uncle, Confessor, was 1057 and became heir, but he died, so she seemed like a good idea. But on her way to England, and then royal Norman invasion



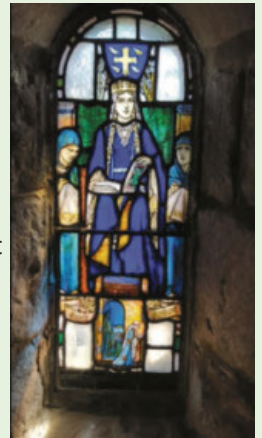

The storm pushed the ship north to Scotland. (Some say she landed at a spot now called, St. Margaret's Hope.) She and her family were taken in by the Scottish king, Malcolm III. Malcolm was a widower and married Margaret in 1070. They ended up having eight children, including the aforementioned David I.

Margaret's influence and piety are famous. She had a calming effect on Malcolm and brought about many reforms to Scotland. She worked to conform the practices of the Scottish Church to those of the continental Church, which she experienced in her childhood. Due to these achievements, she was considered an exemplar of the "just ruler", and moreover influenced her husband and children, especially her youngest son, the future King David I of Scotland, to be just and holy rulers.

"The chroniclers all agree in depicting Queen Margaret as a strong, pure, noble character, who had very great influence over her husband, and through him over Scottish history, especially in its ecclesiastical aspects. Her religion, which was genuine and intense."

Margaret was especially magnanimous to the poor and those who were downtrodden, often feeding them before she ate in the morning. She was dedicated to a life of prayer and was especially devoted to the celebration of Mass. Although King Malcolm was not particularly religious, St. Margaret was unafraid to effectively use her clout with him to advance several projects for the service of the Church. She was instrumental in establishing a ferry for the transportation of pilgrims across the Firth of Forth from Edinburgh to St. Andrew's, where today there stands the towns of South Queensferry and North Queensferry.



Things took a downward turn at the Battle of Aynwick between Scotland and England in 1093. Malcolm and his son Edgar died. Three days later, not yet 50 years old, Margaret died. Some say it was caused by grief.

Less than sixty years later, Margaret was canonized a saint in the church in recognition of her personal holiness, fidelity to the Roman Catholic Church, work for ecclesiastical reform, and charity.

I hope someday you can travel to Edinburgh and even cross the Firth of Forth (they have bridges now) to travel to St. Andrew's, and reflect upon the life of an amazing woman who is renowned in both the Church of England and the Roman Catholic Church, St. Margaret of Scotland.

Her feast is November 16.

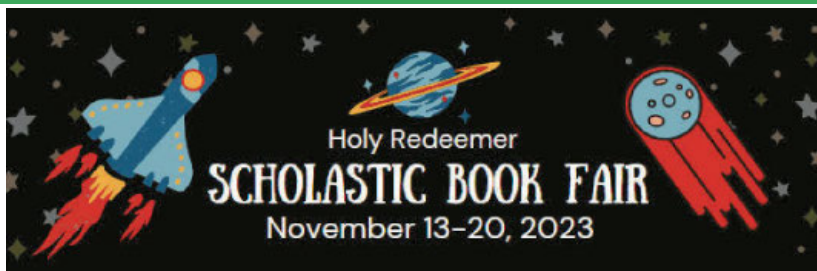

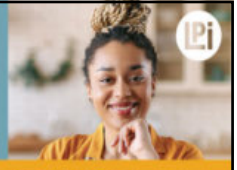
